



Editing Your Fundraising Page

Once logged in, on the left hand side of the screen, there will be a grey Edit My Page button, Click it.






Now you are ready to edit your fundraising page!


You can change your fundraising goal. display name, profile picture, and share directly to Facebook or Twitter by clicking the small gear icon on the top right of each section.
